- E. Events/Fundraising - Earth Day bags will be sold at the event and at future meetings, \$15; Sip and Stroll April 29th (\$15 and tee shirt size) by this Thursday; LI Ducks game July 16th @ 5pm \$11 (need to have tickets by mid June); short sleeved tee fundraiser coming up; Ladies Night probably July 6th at Whale’s Tale
- F. Traffic and Safety - Town put up a sign by the high school but it’s temporary (not a great location either). Steve Stern has said he will get the money for a speed sign on Broadway \$3800-\$5800; have not had confirmation and still waiting to hear. Need to push, it’s election year and might be time to put some pressure on people and draw attention in the newspaper, etc. School district should be putting them in school areas (they have the burden of cost). TOH pays a greater percentage to the PD than other towns but we receive fewer services. Still waiting to hear whether traffic study took place on Greenlawn Road.
