There was a vote to approve amendments to the GCA Bylaws, including changing elections and finances to the calendar year and extending the terms of elected officers *for one year* if no other candidate. Jeanne thanked the Town of Huntington for their outstanding job removing snow on roads and sidewalks. Phil's financial report shows a balance of \$4,289.

Membership Drive is going on now and a table will be set up at Value Drug on Saturday, February 6. The renewal emails have gone out and letters to past members, with no email address, will be mailed.

Since preventative measures are key, Rob is requesting the police to step up enforcement of safety issues. *Traffic & Safety* pushed for a traffic study of Tilden and Greenlawn Road. Northwell will use same footprint as BAE building; expect a conceptual plan next month. TD Bank is scheduled to open June 25 at Cuba and Pulaski. Forty seven homes are coming to Harborfields Estates.
